SPECIFIC MITIGATION MEASURES	The mitigation measures that relate to this site, as set forth in the Water Trail EIR, were the education measures needed to help ensure that Water Trail users would be aware of hunting in the vicinity; the importance of rinsing off boats and equipment on site after use; bird use in the adjacent marshes; boater responsibilities to not get out of watercraft on levees and not get closer than specified buffer distances to both birds and marine mammals; and the need to dress appropriately for an outing on the Bay, taking note of tides and mud flats.
WHAT TO INCLUDE IN ANNUAL REVIEW OF THIS SITE	1) Make sure that WT ID Sign, Educational Signs, and Brochures are still present at site and signs have been maintained, along with basic maintenance of other site facilities; 2) Check in with contact person to learn of any safety issues or wildlife issues that have occurred because of WT users at the site; 3) Check in with Don Edwards San Francisco Bay National Wildlife Refuge staff and the U.S. Coast Guard to learn of any WT-related issues outside of site boundaries but in the vicinity; 4) Learn from any problems that have been solved; work together to seek solutions for any problems not yet resolved; 5) Learn as much as possible about patterns of site usage (boat types, # of users, use of low-float dock vs. concrete ramp), even if anecdotal, and share any information known to WT Staff.
