Dear Joe,

I appreciate your offer to address site management issues observed on Coastal Conservancy properties located in Malibu and Los Angeles County. This letter authorizes the MRCA to take any action authorized by law in the management of any problems observed on, or affecting any of the Coastal Conservancy's Malibu and Los Angeles County properties.

Thank you again for your help in taking down the illegal fence at the Conservancy's Malibu Road property, for installing the trash can and for adding that site to your regular site management circuit. I also appreciate MRCA's assistance with the management of the Conservancy parcels at Carbon-La Costa Beach. The Conservancy would like to be able to provide the MRCA phone number to the immediately adjacent neighbors so that these neighbors could directly call the MRCA to report any management complaints relating to those properties. Additionally, the Conservancy requests the MRCA to provide trash pickup services along the Pacific Coast Highway fence portion of the Carbon-La Costa properties approximately once a quarter annually. The Conservancy wants to make sure that these properties are appropriately managed while we develop our public access plans.

At this time, the MRCA has offered to provide these services to the Conservancy at no fee. If the MRCA's work proves to be more significant than you now anticipate, please don't hesitate to notify me or my staff. Thank you again for your essential partnership with the Conservancy in managing its Malibu and Los Angeles County properties.
