**Lechuza Beach-Clarification Regarding Work to Be Conducted by Geomatrix  
(Contract No. 00-170)**

Dear Ms. Small:

The purpose of this letter to clarify our April 24, 2006 written request to approve Geomatrix as a contractor under this grant for \$28,900. In today's letter, we are specifically asking that funding be reallocated from other tasks to Task 5-Environmental Studies. We are making this request to in anticipation of forthcoming invoices to be submitted by Geomatrix for this project. (The work by McGee Surveying also described in our April 24, 2006 letter has been completed and paid for.)

Specifically, we request that the following amounts from the following tasks be reallocated to Task 5-Environmental Studies:

Task 1-Appraisal Review	\$7,900.00
Task 3-Mapping	\$241.84
Task 4-Design and Install Signs	\$72.18
Unallocated funds	\$1,979.00

Combined with \$15,260.70 of funds already within Task 5-Environmental Studies, all of Geomatrix's work could be billed to Task 5. To clarify, per this letter we are not requesting any additional funds. We are just requesting that the funding to be used to pay for Geomatrix be reallocated from other tasks and specifically be allocated to Task 5-Environmental Studies to simplify the invoicing process.
