**PROJECT:** Redondo Beach Bluffs Native Plant Revegetation Pilot Project

**PROJECT LOCATION:** Two acre southern portion of the Redondo Beach bluffs, just north of Miramar Park at 201 Paseo de la Playa. The project is owned by the County of Los Angeles.

**DESCRIPTION:** The purpose of the Redondo Beach bluffs native plant revegetation project is to remove the exotic vegetation – primarily iceplant (*Carpobrotus edulis*) – currently on the site and replace it with a diverse community of native dune and bluff plants. Two acres of the exotic vegetation will be removed by hand and taken off-site. A temporary irrigation system will be installed.


