



Point Cabrillo Light Station and Preserve Historic Structures Report

Dear Jim:

We have reviewed the final version of the Historic Structures Report (HSR) submitted to you by Carey and Company. The HSR is well organized and easy to follow. The evaluations and general history sections are thorough. The ratings system is well defined and could prove to be an asset to determining the historic sensitivity during restoration/rehabilitation.

It would have been preferable to have more detailed room-by-room recommendations, specifically methods of treatment of the various significant and very significant features in the east house. To compensate for this lack of detail, Carey and Company recommends following the various Secretary of the Interior's Standards. This recommendation will suffice. While they did not include a full set of the Secretary of Interior's Standards, they provided the internet address and these documents are readily available on the website. Overall, the HSR is a sound document that will be useful in guiding any future restoration/rehabilitation plans for the buildings.
