


EXHIBIT 2: Photos



The photo above shows the grade control structure on Marsh Creek and the East Bay Regional Park District Marsh Creek Trail. The structure is a 6 foot drop about 3 miles from the mouth of Marsh Creek. In 2002, NHI documented over 45 salmon immediately downstream of the structure. That same year, DFG surveys identified juvenile salmon in the reach, implying that they had successfully spawned in this reach.

Modifying the drop structure to provide passage would allow access to 6.5 additional stream miles, including approximately 3 miles of suitable spawning habitat (right). Rapid bio-assessments have indicated that the gravel and stream conditions are of good quality for spawning.
