Dear Chairperson Bosco:

On behalf of the Environmental Defense Center (EDC), I am writing in support of Santa Barbara County's application for \$300,000 from the Coastal Conservancy for the Isla Vista Blufftop Parcels Acquisition Project. The EDC is a public interest environmental law firm that represents community organizations dedicated to environmental and resource protection. In the past, we have represented both the Isla Vista Recreation and Park District as well as the Surfrider Foundation in efforts to preserve open space and to protect the Isla Vista bluffs from inappropriate development that results in further erosion and loss of coastal open space.

We support the proposed acquisition because it would preserve precious and dwindling blufftop open space in this densely crowded community. The parcels targeted for acquisition are connected to other publicly owned parcels and this key acquisition would create one larger contiguous open space area. This acquisition would also relieve pressures to construct seawalls or other hard structures along the bluffs by allowing for the implementation of natural restoration and preservation methods (e.g., planting native vegetation, improving drainage systems, etc.). Overall, the entire Isla Vista bluffs area will benefit from this project.


