On June 26, 2007 the Santa Cruz County Parks Department will recommend to the County Board of Supervisors that they accept the transfer of the 11,200 square feet Rockview public access easement from the Surfers Environmental Alliance, as this public easement represents an important coastal access point in the Live Oak area. The County of Santa Cruz is also requesting \$8,987 of funding from the Coastal Conservancy for the next three years to support ongoing maintenance at the site to include signage and the replacement of the seawall fence. These maintenance funds will insure the aesthetic and functionality of this ocean viewpoint.
