*Resolution Approving Funding of \$52,785 from Proposition 12
for Removal of Non-native Species*


WHEREAS, removal of non-native species from the Santa Monica Bay watershed is integral to restoring the watershed to the maximum extent possible; and

WHEREAS, restoration of the watershed and its composite streams, tributaries, and native habitats is a primary component of the Bay Restoration Plan; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project has been previously approved by the Governing Board from Proposition 50 funds, but has been delayed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Monica Bay Restoration Commission Governing Board hereby approves funding of \$52,785 from Proposition 12 funds to the Mountains Restoration Trust for the removal of *Arundo donax* from specifically designated areas within the Malibu Creek area, which is a part of the Santa Monica Bay watershed.
