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GENERAL NOTES

1. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY USA NORTH AT 811 OR 1-800-227-2600 OR WWW.USANORTH.ORG TO REQUEST IDENTIFICATION AND LOCATION OF EXISTING UNDERGROUND UTILITIES. CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT USA NORTH 2 TO 14 DAYS BEFORE PLANNED EXCAVATION DATE.
2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR IDENTIFYING AND AVOIDING DAMAGE TO UNDERGROUND UTILITIES. IF UTILITY CONFLICTS ARE IDENTIFIED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HALT ALL WORK IN THE AREA AFFECTED BY THE UTILITY CONFLICT AND SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE PROJECT MANAGER.
3. THIS PROJECT IS SUBJECT TO REQUIREMENTS OF PERMITS ISSUED BY VARIOUS REGULATORY AGENCIES. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO UNDERSTAND AND PERFORM ALL WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE PERMITS. COPIES OF THE PERMITS HAVE BEEN PROVIDED TO THE CONTRACTOR ALONG WITH THESE PLANS. PRIOR TO COMMENCING WORK THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE PROJECT MANAGER TO VERIFY THE MOST RECENT COPY OF ALL APPLICABLE PERMITS ARE INCORPORATED INTO THE PROJECT CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS.
4. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DEVELOPING AN EROSION CONTROL AND POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN FOR CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. THIS PLAN MUST BE APPROVED BY THE PROJECT MANAGER PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES COMMENCING FOR THIS PROJECT. ELEMENTS OF THE EROSION CONTROL AND POLLUTION PREVENTION ARE SHOWN ON THESE PLANS.
5. ACCESS TO SITE IS THROUGH PUBLIC PROPERTY. CONTRACTOR TO COORDINATE ACCESS, WORK HOURS, AND WORK DATES IN ADVANCE WITH THE SAN MATEO RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT.
6. WHEN CONDITIONS IN THE FIELD DO NOT CONFORM WITH INFORMATION IN THESE PLANS AND/OR WHEN UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES ARISE DURING CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL IMMEDIATELY CONTACT THE PROJECT MANAGER.
7. IN THE EVENT THAT ANY ARCHEOLOGICAL ARTIFACTS ARE UNCOVERED DURING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL STOP ALL WORK IMMEDIATELY IN THE AREA AND CONTACT THE PROJECT MANAGER. WORK IN THE AREA SHALL NOT RESUME UNTIL APPROVED BY THE PROJECT MANAGER.
8. IF A CALIFORNIA RED-LEGGED FROG IS FOUND ON-SITE DURING CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL STOP ALL WORK IMMEDIATELY IN THE AREA AND CONTACT THE PROJECT MANAGER. WORK WILL RESUME ONCE A USFWS-PERMITTED AND TRAINED BIOLOGIST CAN CAPTURE, TRANSFER, AND RELEASE THE FROG(S) IN A SAFE AREA.
9. DURING CONSTRUCTION THE PROJECT MANAGER OR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE MAY MAKE ADJUSTMENTS TO THE DESIGN TO ACCOMMODATE CONDITIONS ENCOUNTERED AT THE SITE.
10. CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE TO THE FOLLOWING SPECIFICATIONS AND PROVISIONS:
 - PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS
 - CALTRANS STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS 2010
11. THIS PLAN SET SUPERSEDES THE PREVIOUS APRIL 19 2013 SIGNED PLAN SET.




