


Figure 1. Map of historical distribution of native oysters on the west coast in the early 1900's.




Figure 5. The implementation of the San Diego Bay Oyster Restoration Plan would result in one or more small oyster beds, such as the one pictured here, which was constructed through the San Francisco Bay Living Shorelines Project.
