Dear Mr. Bosco:

As the San Diego County Supervisor for the district that includes the City of Solana Beach, I am writing in support of the City of Solana Beach's grant application for the Del Mar Shores Beach Access Stairway Project.

The Del Mar Shores Beach Access Stairway is accessed off of Del Mar Shores Terrace in the City of Solana Beach. Since the coastal bluffs line the entire length of the city's westerly boundary, the Del Mar Shores Beach Access Stairway is one of only four beach access points in Solana Beach. Due to safety concerns, the existing stairway has been closed since November 2012. The city is in the final design stage for the new stairway and anticipates that construction of the new stairway will begin in January 2014. Generally speaking, this project will remove and replace the existing beach access stairway.

The City of Solana Beach has an excellent track record of preserving and enhancing public lands and access to coastal areas and the beach. One great example of this is Fletcher Cove Park which transformed an asphalt parking lot into a bluff top park that allows access to the beach. Dear Chairman Bosco and Members of the Coastal Conservancy,

I write in support of the application submitted by the City of Solana Beach to fund the Del Mar Shores Beach Access Stairway Reconstruction Project, located off of Del Mar Shores Terrace in Solana Beach.

Coastal bluffs line the entire length of the City's westerly boundary, and the Del Mar Shores Beach Access Stairway is one of only four public beach access points in Solana Beach. Due to safety concerns, the existing stairway has been closed since November 2012. The City hopes to initiate the repairs that will remove and replace the existing beach access stairway in order to restore beach access to the public at this location.

The City of Solana Beach has an excellent track record of preserving and enhancing public lands and access to coastal areas and the beach. For example, the Fletcher Cove Park project transformed an asphalt parking lot into a bluff top park allowing access to the beach.

I urge the Commission to support the proposed \$200,000 allocation for this important stairway project.


Dear Mr. Bosco:

Coastwalk California enthusiastically supports Coastal Conservancy funding for the City of Solana Beach's Del Mar Shores Stairway project.

The Del Mar Shores Beach Access Stairway is one of only four beach access points in Solana Beach. Due to safety concerns, the existing stairway has been closed since November 2012. This proposed project will remove and replace the existing beach access stairway. Upon completion of the construction project, this public beach access point will be reopened for the public to enjoy and will be owned and maintained by the City of Solana Beach.

The beaches in Solana Beach are very popular and a huge economic asset to the City. It is imperative to reopen this beach access point, not only to fulfill the Coastal Act's requirement for public access, but also to sustain Solana Beach's premier economic asset - coastal recreation.
