Upgrade existing trails at Fleener and Guthrie Creek, develop new ADA compliant trail, develop/open new recreation opportunities at former Centerville Bluffs Naval Station including picnic tables, permanent environmental restrooms (at Bluffs and Guthrie Trail head), new split rail vehicle barricade fencing, replacement of cyclone fencing with low profile wire fencing, removal of unneeded grazing pasture fencing, removal of some old and overhanging Monterey Pines and eucalyptus for safety purposes and graveling the existing paved area for Bluffs parking. Guthrie and Fleener upgrades include reducing size of Fleener parking area, installing rolling dips on trails, regraveling, brushing, install steps at base of Guthrie trail.
