The Great Highway Pilot Project will include significant project outcomes pertaining to stakeholder engagement, analysis and report deliverables that will be critical to inform long-range physical outcomes in the project study area. Among these outcomes are the following:

- Engage up to 40 community stakeholder groups
- Receive 5000 online surveys
- Host 3 site tours
- Up to four publicly vetted design alternatives for the Great Highway Corridor that address future recreation, transportation, and ecological needs in the form
- Completion of three technical studies that report on 1) ecological impacts related to climate change and mitigation strategies, 2) transportation data collection, analysis and intersection and arterials evaluation and 3) recreational use conditions and opportunities.
- Secure vote of support of Great Highway Pilot Project for 2-mile recreational corridor by RPD Commission
- Secure approval of Great Highway Pilot Project by SF Board of Supervisors for traffic and recreational uses of the roadway after December 2025.
- Public participation plan that includes strategic communication, briefing and in-person meetings, online engagement, and in-park (on-site) engagement.
- Greater public understanding of travel and access demand for the Great Highway and adjacent corridors and insights into recreational uses and behaviors
- Ecological Impacts findings (habitat, coastal erosion, SLR impacts, sand and wind impacts) and strategies for implementing and funding improved plant, animal and ecologically sensitive site improvements and management to address impacts and incorporated into alternative plan (50 ac total area of RPD project site)
- Gap analysis and identification of recreation facility types that are lacking across different communities in proximity to the existing Great Highway
