



Resolution in Honor of Jeremiah Hallisey

California State Coastal Conservancy

Whereas, Jeremiah Hallisey, a member of the Coastal Conservancy since September 2023, passed away on July 17, 2026.

Whereas, Jeremiah, known as Jerry to his friends and colleagues, was a San Francisco legend in both law and political acumen. Jerry served on the University of California Board of Regents, the California Transportation Commission, and the California Commission for Economic Development. He was an inveterate reader, a lover of books, and a lifelong Boston Red Sox fan. He was generally taciturn, but state and national office holders, including presidents and governors, respected his political acumen and called on him for advice. Jerry served as a mentor and counselor to many colleagues. He was committed to public service throughout his career. That commitment led to his appointment to the Conservancy by Governor Newsom in 2023.

Now, therefore, the State Coastal Conservancy honors Jeremiah Hallisey for his support for the work of the Coastal Conservancy, and thanks him for his service to the people and environment of California and for his support for the other board members and staff.
